



Voluntary Deregistration Authority Form

- › Deregistration under section 18 of the Financial Service Providers (Registration and Dispute Resolution) Act 2008 ('the Act') can be requested by the financial service provider (voluntary deregistration). All deregistration requests must be submitted online at the Financial Service Providers Register website <https://fsp-register.companiesoffice.govt.nz>
- › If you're a third-party requesting deregistration of an FSP, the FSP must complete and sign this form authorising you to submit a request on their behalf.
- › The signed copy of this authority form should then be uploaded as a document supporting your deregistration request.
